



TRUCK PARKING EUROPE: FROM APP TO BOOKING PLATFORM

The Truck Parking Europe app is a household name amongst European truck drivers. Currently showing over 36.000 parking locations, big and small, across Europe. Since 2018, transport companies can pre-reserve a guaranteed parking spot at carefully selected partner locations.

We interviewed Lars Kobesen, Business Development Manager at our new partner Truck Parking Europe, on how they pivoted their business from mobile application to full scale booking platform.

How did Truck Parking Europe start?

Lars; we started with a map of 9.000 parking locations, mostly situated along the highway. Drivers quickly discovered our app and provided us with an enormous amount of feedback on existing and new locations. This information was used by our first Shareholder PTV Group to further optimise their route-planning systems and software.

What made you change from app to platform?

Beginning of 2018 we saw a huge spike in the number of locations that were being claimed by their respective owners on our web app. At the same time, more transport companies were finding their way to our platform. That got us thinking; How can we connect these groups, helping both the driver and dispatcher, as well as our parking operator partners.



Did you directly come to the current setup?

Yes and no. We quickly saw that offering advertising space in our app was not ideal for the driver experience. At the same time, our web app was growing and the search filters where being used more and more. With Repsol we got our first partner to accept online reservations. At the same time, we started talking with our new and main shareholder Volkswagen Financial Services, who emphasized their interest in Truck Parking Europe and its ability to offer a booking.com-like service platform for truck parking.

Where do you currently stand?

Beginning of 2019 we breached the milestone of 1 million downloads and at the same time we signed our 40th bookable location. That number expands to 90 locations by the end of this year, making us the fastest growing network of bookable secure truck parking locations in Europe.



What is your main challenge?

Our challenge is two-fold. At one side we keep getting requests from transport companies for more secure bookable locations. For example, in the triangle Frankfurt, Stuttgart and Nuremberg or at the French Spanish border. In the end there is a huge demand for these locations across the continent.

The other one is digitisation in the transport sector and increased market acceptance to pay for parking. Many companies are used to their current way of working and changing behaviour does not happen overnight. We are expanding our team so we can knock on more doors and further grow the number of active transport companies on our platform. In the end we will be able to offer them secure European corridors.

What are your expectations for 2020?

We are an ambitious company; currently 14 certified ES-PORG locations are connected to our platform, I say we should double this amount in 2020!

That seems like a goal we can all agree upon. Is there more to come in 2020?

Yes, for sure. We will be launching a new web app that will drastically improve the user experience for companies and make booking a parking spot as easy as 1,2,3. With the expansion of our sales and marketing team we keep pushing the digitisation agenda across the sector. We are all aware that keeping driver and cargo safe is of the highest importance and we're happy to have found a great partner for this in ESPORG.

SDAG - GORIZIA INTERPORTO:



SDAG is an intermodal and logistic platform on the border between Italy and Slovenia that covers an area of more than 600,000 sq and offers a wide range of services for international commerce and road and rail transport from/to Central and Eastern Europe, acting as the best way to reach Ljubljana, Hungary and Eastern Europe giving access to the TEN-T Corridors.

Thanks to its strategic position, just right on the Italian highway and before the border with Slovenia, Gorizia Truck Parking is easy to reach. It is positioned in the junction point between the A34 italian highway that is directly linked to/from A4 highway and H4 Slovenian highway that connects directly with Ljubljana and Hungary.



CERTIFIED AS A SAFE AND SECURE TRUCK PARKING



In the A34 highway in 2018 almost 1.8 millions trucks have been registered against the only 100,000 registered in 1982 (SDAG foundation year) and this is why, as stated by the CEO of SDAG Giuliano Grendene: "the working conditions of truck drivers are nowadays even more important and Gorizia Interporto wanted to make a step further together with ESPORG starting the certification procedure".

As a matter of fact, inside its huge area, Gorizia Interpor-

to hosts several truck parking areas for a total of 550 parking slots, offering therefore different services to truck drivers that are useful to make safer and more secure, but also more comfortable, the short or long stop in its parking areas. All the

parking areas have a video surveillance 24/7, fences, shelters, toilets and showers, free WI-FI, vending machines, minimarket, but also picnic areas and a snack-bar...

In November 2019 SDAG-Gorizia Interporto obtained the LABEL certification as a "Safe and Secure Truck Parking" for two truck parking areas: three locks for the Gorizia Interporto truck parking and two locks for the Frontier Station truck parking. The certifications followed also a full-day training made by the EU Parking Academy.

Actually, in Italy only two entites obtained the certification, and one of these is "SDAG-Gorizia Interporto" together with "Autoparco Brescia Est", both members of ESPORG.

Now SDAG is already looking forward and is working to get the next certification with the new EU-Parking Standard.





SECURITPARK, THE FIRST SECURE TRUCK PARKING AREA IN WESTERN FRANCE, HAS DOUBLED ITS CAPACITY



Extension and infrastructure investments of SecuriTpark the 1st Western France secure truck parking area Centre Routier La Crèche - Deux-Sèvres, FR – Junction of motorways A10/A83

SecuriTpark, the first Western France secure truck parking area, has doubled its capacity of parking spaces for trucks.

SecuriTpark was created by the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Deux-Sèvres in 2009. This secure truck parking area is located in an exceptional location in the Western Atlantic at the "Centre Routier La Crèche", Deux-Sèvres, at the junction of motorways A10/A83.

Since its opening, its growth has been steadily increasing. An extension has been carried out, doubling the number of parking spaces from 40 to 90, strengthening its position as the first Western France secure truck parking area.

The level of safety and comfort has been reinforced providing better comfort for the drivers and more security for goods. It has been awarded the "ESPORG Certificate for Security Parking Areas". SecuriTpark complies with the requirements of PSR (parking security requirements).

SecuriTpark offers fully automated parking systems - a 2,40 m fully-fenced area with a security entrance/exit for trucks and pedestrians

- a 24 hour CCTV system covering the entry and exit movements with recorded data
- a night-lighting site for drivers' safety and comfort.

Facilities and services provided for the drivers have been improved such as a washroom area (toilets and showers), a picnic tables area with a shelter and free illimited WiFi access. Next to the site, there are a restaurant with a relaxation room with TV and other services such as petrol station, and licensed automotive businesses.

In the near future, it will be possible to book online.
